## POINT COOK CRICKET CLUB - TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### Purpose:

to outline the terms and conditions of membership with Point Cook Cricket Club (further known as: "the Club").

All terms and conditions of membership are within the bounds of the Club Constitution and our player code of conduct.

### Affected Parties:

"Juniors" - Any player playing in Club junior teams, Blaster cricket or representing the Club in representative cricket.

"Parents" – Parents and Guardians of players playing in Club junior teams Blaster cricket or representing the Club in representative cricket.

"Senior Men" – Players playing in Senior Men's competitions irrespective of age. "Senior Women" - Players playing in Senior Women's competitions irrespective of age.

"Social Members" – Non-Playing members who have taken up a Social Membership with the Club.

"Spectators" – Non-Members of the club excluding parents of Junior players who have a non-official alignment with the Club.

"Club Officials" - Stated volunteers, committee members, and employees of the Club.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

### 1. EVENT CONDUCT:

An Event refers to any scheduled activity organised by the Club, including, but not limited to - training sessions, practice matches, game days, and social events.

### 2. MEMBERSHIP APPROVAL:

Registration and membership (or membership renewal) is subject to acceptance of the following conditions and the provision of complete and accurate responses.

- All memberships are accepted or declined by committee review against the club Constitution.

### 3. PLAYER SEASON PERMITS INBOUND AND OUTBOUND:

Players and parents/guardians accept that the Club will not allow a player to play for the Club, and also play for another club in the same age group.

The Club's expectations are for all players to be loyal and respectful to the Club.

Season permits will not be approved if they are deemed to be contrary to the best interests of the Club, its teams, or its overarching purpose.

### 4. VOLUNTEERING:

From time to time, the Club may request assistance from members in supporting the delivery of services to our community. This may include, but is not limited to:

- ground preparation, game day support, social events, fundraising activities, committee involvement, and coaching roles.

As a member of the Club, it is expected that you contribute a reasonable amount of volunteer time to help support the effective operation and success of the Club.

#### **4.1 Junior Volunteer Levy:**

Eligibility to receive the \$50 Volunteer Levy refund, issued as a fee credit for the following season, is at the discretion of Club officials and is available once per family, per year in recognition of meaningful contribution to Club or team activities.

### **5. REFUNDS:**

#### **5.1 Juniors:**

Where a financial player decides to terminate their membership with the Club BEFORE Round 1 of the player's registered season, for reasons other than injury, they will be refunded 50% of their MEMBERSHIP fees. Cricket Victoria's processing fees and the WRJCA Player Levy Fees are excluded from the refund, as these are paid to external entities, not the Club.

Once Round 1 of the current season has started, if a player decides to terminate their membership for reasons other than injury, they will NOT be entitled to a refund.

If a player has an injury that stops them from playing cricket during the season, players can apply to Committee for a refund. A pro-rata refund may apply where Committee approves the refund. All refunds will be paid at the end of the applicable season. If a player applies for a refund due to injury and then plays at another club during the season, a refund is refused and will not be paid.

#### **5.2 Senior Men, Senior Women:**

When a player registers with the Club, they are accepting an obligation to pay the membership fees in FULL. Where a registered player subsequently decides not to play, this obligation continues and there will be NO refund of any membership fees paid. The committee commits financially to Senior team structures early in the pre-season according to the number of registered players. The Committee also caps player numbers according to this team structure. Change of mind / clubs will not see a refund issued. The only exception is where players are injured. In this case, this will be at the discretion of Committee and if allowed, will be pro-rata and the refund paid at the end of the season. If a player applies for a refund due to injury and then plays at another club during the season, a refund is refused and will not be paid.

### **6. COMPLAINTS PROCESS:**

### **7. BREACH OF TERMS:**

Failure to adhere to these Terms and Conditions may result in disciplinary action by the Club, including warnings, suspensions, or cancellation of memberships (no refunds).

### **8. FEES AND REGISTRATIONS**

All membership and registration fees must be paid in full (or under an agreed payment plan) before the start of the season.

Non-payment of fees will result in the player being ineligible for selection until the matter is resolved.
